Class: I

Ones and Tens

Ones (O):

- Numbers **1 to 9** have only one digit, so they are called one- digit numbers. We need only one place to write them. This place is called **Ones (O)** place.

Tens (T):

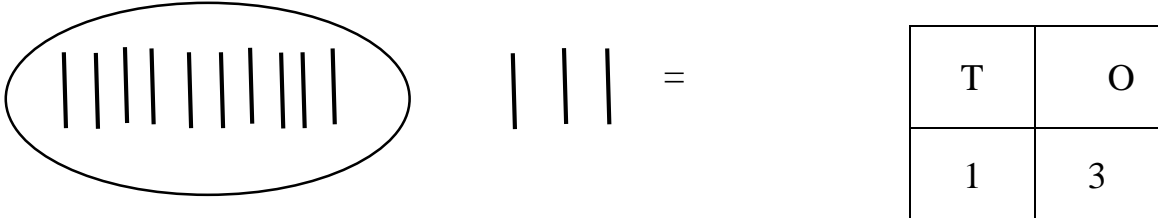
T	O
1	0

- Number **10** has two digits, so it is called a two-digit number. We need two places to write it.
- The place on the right is called **Ones (O)** place, while on the left is called **tens (T)** place.

In above example, the number 10, **0** is at the ones place and **1** is at the tens place.

Problems:

1. Counting in Tens and Ones.

1 ten

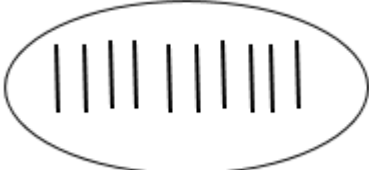
