## Ones and Tens

## Ones ( O ):

- Numbers 1 to 9 have only one digit, so they are called one- digit numbers. We need only one place to write them. This place is called Ones (O) place.

Tens (T):

| $\mathbf{T}$ | 0 |
| :---: | :---: |
| 1 | 0 |

- Number 10 has two digits, so it is called a two-digit number. We need two places to write it.
- The place on the right is called Ones (O) place, while on the left is called tens (T) place.

In above example, the number 10,0 is at the ones place and 1 is at the tens place.
